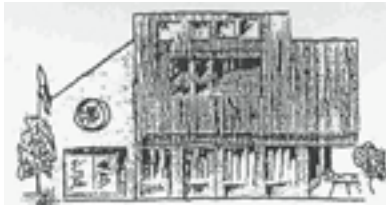

From time to time, we need to review the important purposes of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. You will find these purposes in our "Congressional Charter" under Section 230102.

Many of you are doing things each week that aid in these purposes and may not even know it. When you volunteer in a blood drive, visit a hospitalized veteran (even if it is your brother), help a needy veteran or any community service, you are performing community involvement which is a VFW priority.

The Voice of Democracy, Patriot's Pen youth essay contest and Scout of the Year programs are other important Post activities that help foster true patriotism. Help your Post by becoming involved in these activities.
